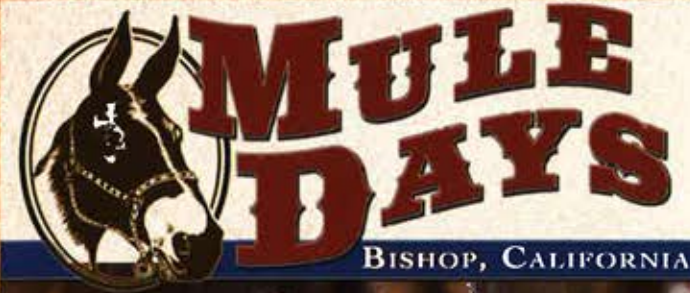

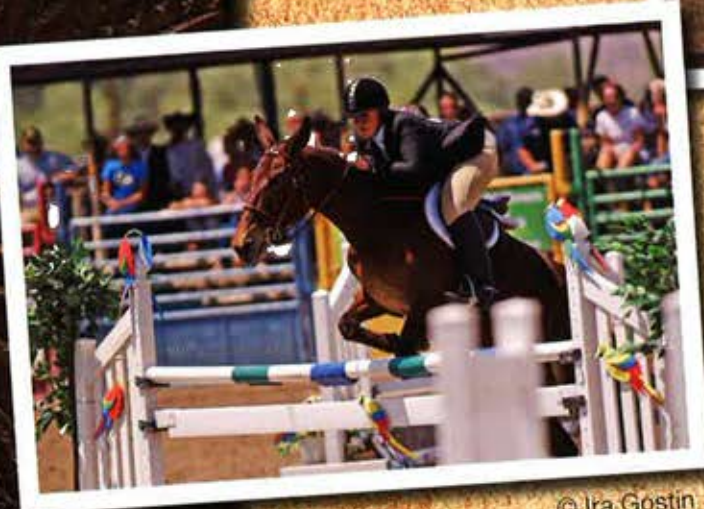

Every Memorial Day weekend since 1969, the town of Bishop, nestled on the eastern slope of the majestic Sierra Nevada mountains, comes alive with the annual presentation of the Mule Days Celebration.

The outfitters and packers of the region wanted an event to start off the packing season and the businessmen wanted to draw vacationers to the Owens Valley. What began as an informal gathering and a test of skills, has now grown into a fun-filled, world class event.

There is no way to actually describe Mule Days. It is part mule show, part test of skills, and part Wild West show. It

is an event the likes of which are held no where else in the world. During the six days of the event, there are 14 shows

featuring more than 700 mules with their trainers, riders and packers. In excess of 30,000 fans converge on the Tri-County Fairgrounds and the Mike Boothe Arena to watch the events and visit the exhibitors.

The competitors, all hardcore mule aficionados, are determined to prove that anything a good horse can do, a mule can do better! Events include English jumping, dressage, team

roping, western riding, and racing, to name a few. The pack scrambles, chariot racing, musical tires and other unique events are not to be missed!
